### **PRESCRIBED BURN NOTIFICATION – LAMEROUGH CREEK WEST ENVIRONMENT RESERVE**

As a component of the council bushland fire management program, sections of Lamerough Creek West Environment Reserve have again been identified as requiring a prescribed burn. Prior to burning, a *permit to light fire* will be issued to council by the Queensland Fire & Emergency Services (QFES). The burn/s will be conducted by officers from the Sunshine Coast Council and where available, QFES. During the burn/s, access to parts of the reserve will be restricted.

An exact day for prescribed burning cannot be provided in advance, as prescribed burn timing is highly dependent on specific weather conditions. These conditions include, temperature, humidity, wind-speed and wind direction. The burn will only take place if weather and site conditions are suitable.

Council wishes to notify neighbours of our intent to undertake the prescribed burn/s in line with the following details:

- ❖ **Date Range:** 20 April 2020 to 30 September 2020
- ❖ **Time:** Between 10am & 8pm
- ❖ **Burn location:** Lamerough Creek West Environment Reserve, Tweddell Dr PELICAN WATERS. Lot on Plan: 972SP259001 & 975SP278711 (map attached).
- ❖ **Purpose:** Reduce forest fuels to protect assets, lessen the potential impacts of wildfire and maintain a fire adapted ecosystems.

Please note, only small sections of the reserve are to be burnt. The proposed burn area will be limited to approximately 10 hectares and is not expected to include all of the areas shown on the map (map attached). A number of sites have been selected to provide options throughout the prescribed burn season depending on weather conditions and resourcing. Where possible, smoke from the fire/s will be carefully managed to reduce impacts on the surrounding community.

Close to the day of the proposed burn/s, specific notifications will be provided, as follows;
